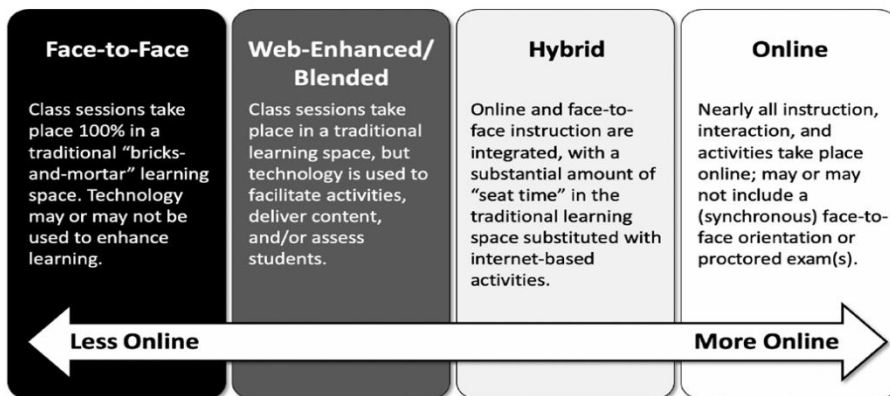


Implementing Hybrid Learning within your school.
